Our Purpose

To create thriving communities by promoting community cohesion, empowering communities by raising aspirations and ensuring our customers have access to all available benefits and services.

Our Chair's comments

This has been yet another challenging year for us due to the high inflation, increasing interest rates and the ongoing cost of living crisis. This has had a significant impact on our property maintenance and repairs budget and our rent collection work. Our surplus for the year has fallen noticeably from previous years due to the high cost of servicing our loans and increased operational costs.

As many of our residents already being on low income, during the crisis, we supported our residents by giving information about supports available from the government, the energy suppliers, and the local agencies. We set up a Tenants Welfare Fund and obtained grants from Hackney Giving- LB Hackney to deliver shopping vouchers to our vulnerable residents.

On a positive note, I am delighted that we were able to finally purchase Bangla House from ISHA. Bangla had been managing this scheme since it was built in 1994.

We are getting a lot of positive feedback from the community and those who are involved with the 'Amar bari, amar jibon' (My home, my life) research project. This 3-year project is being led by The Open University in partnership with Bangla HA and Housing LIN (Learning and Information Network). Involving members from the community and professional advisors, the project will explore diversity and inclusion in later life living environments for the Bangladeshi elders (Probins) in East London.

Our staff team have been working tirelessly in these challenging times to ensure that all our services to our residents were fully delivered. I am pleased to note that, during the year, we have been able to meet our financial and housing management performance targets. You will be able to find out more about this as well as further information given in this report.

I must thank my Board colleagues, and the staff team for their passionate and hard work over the year and especially during this difficult time.

I am grateful to our RP and Local Authority partners as well as all the statutory and voluntary agencies for their continued support with our work.

Our Chief Executive's Statement

Since Covid-19 pandemic, the increasingly high cost of energy and shopping bills had a serious impact on the finances and mental health of many of our residents. We have been working with the Local Authorities, energy suppliers and our partner agencies seeking alternative ways of supporting our residents during these difficult times.

We managed to deliver all essential housing management services meeting our key performance targets. We focused on our de-carbonisation programme to bring all our housing stock to meet required EPC rating by 2030. To do this we joined a consortium led by ISHA to obtain part funding from the government. We expect to complete this work by 2025 spending around £200k of our reserve funds.

Following from the successful delivery of our award-winning Bangla Covid-19 Advice Project (BCAP), we have been actively engaged with the City and Hackney Public Health Community Champions Forum supporting health awareness and vaccination programmes in the community.

As a community organisation partner, Bangla HA has been actively supporting The Open University and Housing LIN on the Amar Bari, Amar Jibon (My Home, My Life) a pioneering 3-year partnership research project funded by the Dunhill Medical Trust.

Similarly, we continued working with our strategic partners including the BME London Landlords group learning from best practice and delivering value for money services to our residents and the community.

I am grateful to the Board for providing the staff the support and guidance during another difficult year due to the ongoing cost-of-living crisis and the high cost of borrowing impacting our business, residents, and the community.



We know there is more we can do and so we are always seeking our residents' views and working with our partner providers to learn from best practice and share knowledge and resources to provide the best Value of Money for our residents.

Lettings: During the year we re-let 2 flats: 1 x 1 bedroom and 1 x 2 bedroom Both units were let to council nominations.

Mutual exchange completions: During the year we helped two families with home swaps.: 1x 2bed and 1x 3bed in Hackney.

Cost of living crisis

High inflation, rising cost of food and energy bills had a serious impact on our resident's everyday family budget. Majority of our residents are on low income and on benefits. We supported our residents by giving information about supports available from the government and the local council using email, newsletter, whatsapp messages and through our website. We have given energy saving tips, helping vulnerable residents with submitting support payment applications online and referring residents to support agencies e.g., council's family fund for food and fuel vouchers and food banks. Bangla set up a Tenants Welfare Fund to help to support with one off payments to vulnerable tenants from Bangla's own resources.

In March 2023 we obtained grant of £6000 from Hackney Giving- LB Hackney. We used this grant to deliver shopping vouchers to vulnerable individuals and families amongst our residents as well as some people from the Bangladeshi and Muslim communities living in Hackney. We helped 20 pensioners and 40 families through this project.

BCAP Legacy work

Following the delivery of our award winning and lifesaving Bangla Covid-19 Advice Project (BCAP) during the Pandemic, in 2020/21, we continued with working on community health projects in partnership with Hackney Public Health Team, Hackney Volunteer Centre, and the NHS.

PHCC - Community Champions Forum

Bangla HA is an active member of the Hackney Public Health Community Champions Forum. By attending the monthly Forum meetings, we have given our feedback and gathered the health information and resources includina vaccinations. diabetes. and long-term conditions. We then shared this information with our residents and the community including signposting to relevant service providers and resources improving access to the health services for our residents and the community.

Our Community Research Project

'Amar bari, amar jibon' (My home, my life)

Bangla HA in partnership with The Open University and Housing LIN (Learning and Information Network) launched this pioneering 36-month long research project 26/03/2021 coinciding with the Bangladesh Independence Day. This research project named in Bengali 'Amar bari, amar jibon' (My home, my life)' is funded by The Dunhill Medical Trust and led by The Open University. It is a co-designed and co-produced project about developing living environments for Bangladeshi elders, that will focus on the entrenched housing and health inequalities of Bangladeshi elders in East London. Bangladeshi local communities practitioners, it will together explore diversity and in later life living environments communities which will inform local authorities, the government and policy makers with hard facts about the housing and health needs and aspirations of the Bangladeshi elders (Probins) living in East London.



Purchase of Bangla House

Bangla purchased this small block of flats on 31/10/2022 from ISHA. This scheme comprises of 2x4-bedroom houses and 3x2-bedroom flats in Hackney. Bangla has been managing these properties since they were built in 1994.







Bangla Research Advisory Group (BRAG) meeting

Duke House

We handed back a block of 15 flats in Hackney to the owners of this building, Notting Hill Genesis in November 2022. We have been managing these properties since they were built in 2009. We have done this by mutual agreement as they were no longer cost effective for us to continue to manage them.

Our investments in our stock

New installations

During the year 2022/23, Bangla renewed 8 kitchens and 11 boilers and 2 bathrooms spending £95,070. We spent £12,780 on cyclical work and £5,978 on major repairs.

Fire Safety

During the year we complied with fire safety regulations. We communicated with all residents to reassure them that their buildings are safe and advised them about their responsibilities to keep all communal their areas and homes safe from any fire risks.

All gas checks are up to date and any works as recommended following our annual Fire Risk Assessments were carried out promptly.

De-carbonisation work

Bangla is committed to reducing carbon emissions from its properties. All social landlords are required to have their properties at EPC rating C or above by 2030.

Currently Bangla owns 17 properties, that need work to bring up to required standard. Bangla joined a consortium bid led by ISHA for 50% funding from the government towards the cost of this work. This bid has been successful, but Bangla still must spend around £200K from its reserves to complete the work by March 2025.
